Commissioners to continue discussion of comprehensive plan update

Vancouver, WA -- The Board of Clark County Commissioners will hold a work session October 25 to continue the discussion of specific areas that could be designated for urban uses under the Comprehensive Growth Management Plan. The work session, which takes place at 2 p.m. in the county's Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, is open to the public.

County staff developed a "draft discussion map" that was presented at a work session on September 27. The map represents the first step in the development of a proposal for new urban growth areas that will be the focus of an environmental review process in 2006. The draft discussion map will be based on previous input, including proposals from cities and property owners as well as guidelines from commissioners.

Staff was directed to work with the cities in a process to refine the draft discussion map. This work session is to be a discussion of the progress in this effort. Another work session is tentatively scheduled for November 1 at 2 p.m. on the same topic.
